



## RoHS COMPLIANCE

In February 2003, the European Union issued Directive 2002/95/EC on the restriction of the use of certain hazardous substances in electrical and electronic equipment (RoHS).

This RoHS directive requires producers to eliminate the use of six environmentally – sensitive substances: lead, mercury, cadmium, hexavalent chromium, and the use of PBB and PBDE flame retardants in their products sold in the European Union beginning July 1, 2006.
