

Confirmation concerning absence of heavy metals and compliance with EU Directive 2002/95/EC (RoHS Directive) for Polyamide Monofilament yarns

We may confirm, that for the production of all Polyamide Monofilament yarns, manufactured by Rhodia Polyamide Polska Sp. z.o.o. Gorzów / Poland and by Rhodia Industrial Yarns AG Emmenbrücke / Switzerland no lead, mercury, cadmium, chromium^{VI} as well as no Polybrominated Biphenyls (PBB) and no Polybrominated Diphenylethers (PBDE) are used neither as raw materials nor as additives. Additionally, no raw materials or additives containing the above mentioned heavy metals and hazardous substances are used for the manufacturing of the yarns.

We therefore can declare, that to the best of our knowledge, the mentioned yarns are in compliance with RoHS Directive 2002/95/EC "*on restriction of the use of certain hazardous substances in electrical and electronic equipment*" (27.01.2003)

This confirmation is notably true for the Polyamide yarns type E111, F110, F111, Z054, A181 and D183

The confirmation is true for the Monofilament yarns in the state of delivery.
